# **Safety**

#### Independent Double Checks for High Alert Medications and Barcoding

- Wasting of narcotics Verify medication wasting by witnessing.
  Never assume
- Medications MD must administer paralytics, first bolus of propofol.
  RN may administer medications during Rapid Sequence Intubation
- ♦ Shift Change gtt verification and documentation

## **Transportation of Patients**

- ♦ RN must accompany patients with telemetry
  - \* If transporting to SD unit RN must go
  - If transporting to Floor with tele RN must go
  - \* If transporting to MRI on ICU status RN must stay
  - \* If transporting to MRI on SDS RN does not stay if MRI RN is present
- Orientee should not be the only RN during first few weeks of orientation. After appropriate milestones met, orientee may transport without mentor/acuity.
- ♦ Orientees are to transport patients when possible to master skill
- ♦ Ambu bag with mask for transportation
- ♦ Resident may be asked to accompany if patient is unstable

#### Security

## **Personal Safety**

- ♦ PPE
- What to do if exposed—Immediately wash area. If mouth, ears, nose, eyes—flush. Notify Charge RN immediately. (They will follow appropriate steps,)

- ♦ Beds—Notify Bed Shop #9039
- Electronic—Notify Biomedical Engineering (aka Healthcare Technologies Management) #74194 (they will not pick up damaged equipment from soiled utility rooms, they must be called)
- ♦ Room Fixtures/plumbing/electrical—Notify Facilities #77107
