As a key member of the oncology research team, the Oncology Clinical Research Specialist drives progress in cancer treatments and care.

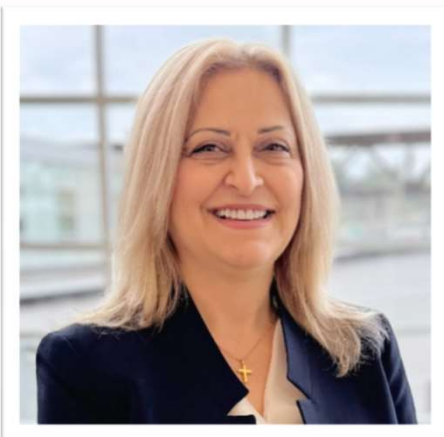
Oncology clinical research specialist role:

Collaborates closely with multidisciplinary teams. They design, implement and oversee clinical trials, ensuring strict adherence to regulatory requirements and Good Clinical Practice (GCP) standards

Key responsibilities include:

- Identifying and activating clinical trials
- Recruiting patients
- Conducting research follow-up
- Collecting and managing high quality data
- Collaborating with investigators and research staff to troubleshoot and resolve issues.

Through our work, we facilitate the development of innovative therapies and treatments, enhance patient outcomes, and advance the field of cancer research, ultimately deepening our understanding of cancer and its management.
