

Criteria for Pediatric **PRIORITY III** Activation Response

Applies to patients age ≤ 16

Priority III Criteria

REQUIRED RESPONSE: LIMITED TRAUMA TEAM ACTIVATION

Primary evaluation on arrival by Emergency Medicine

Trauma to evaluate within 60 minutes

Documentation: EPIC

Anatomy

1. Stable facial fractures with/without loss of consciousness, **WITHOUT** respiratory compromise
2. Suspected or confirmed spinal fracture **WITHOUT** neurologic deficits/symptoms
3. Rib fractures not meeting P1 or P2 criteria
4. Stable confirmed solid organ injury

Mechanism

1. Envenomation requiring admission
2. Emergency physician discretion for patient with concern for traumatic injury >24 hours (transfer and scene)
