### Criteria for Pediatric PRIORITY III Activation Response

Applies to patients age <16

## Priority III Criteria

# REQUIRED RESPONSE: LIMITED TRAUMA TEAM ACTIVATION Primary evaluation on arrival by Emergency Medicine

Trauma to evaluate within 60 minutes

Documentation: EPIC

### Anatomy

- Stable facial fractures with/without loss of consciousness, WITHOUT respiratory compromise
- 2. Suspected or confirmed spinal fracture WITHOUT neurologic deficits/symptoms
- 3. Rib fractures not meeting P1 or P2 criteria
- 4. Stable confirmed solid organ injury

#### Mechanism

- 1. Envenomation requiring admission
- Emergency physician discretion for patient with concern for traumatic injury >24
   hours (transfer and scene)
