



## The Trauma Resuscitation Room – Ruby ED

### Where to Find What You Need

- The preferred Pediatric Trauma room is ED TR01 – however, pediatric traumas can be placed in any trauma bay
- You will notice the Broselow Cart (Peds Cart) is up against the wall behind the bed – this cart contains suction and urinary catheters, feeding tubes, chest tubes, BP cuffs, etc.
- Drawers are arranged by expected weight as determined by length on Broselow Tape
- The Broselow Tape is in plastic cover and on top of the cart
- There is a Pediatric Trauma Cart in the ED, located in the storage area for Specialty Carts. Ask the ED nurse for this cart if it is needed and is not already in the room
- The Pediatric Trauma Cart has the standard layout to reflect the priority in the resuscitation
- Pediatric intubation supplies, including ETTs and Mac/Miller blades are located in the blue Pediatric Airway Bag
- Pediatric Airway Bags are located on top of the Broselow Cart in ED TR01, on top of the Broselow Cart in the ED CDU, and on top of the Pediatric Trauma Cart
- Pediatric IV start kits and lab collection supplies are located in the top drawer of the Broselow Carts and the top drawer of the monitor supply cabinet in each trauma bay
- Suctioning equipment is on the wall, as is oxygen
- Peds BVMs and appropriately sized cervical collars are located on the Broselow Cart
- There is a papoose board attached to the Broselow Cart in ED TR01
- Please, when you enter the room, please make yourself known to the ED RN scribe and be certain to sign yourself in, if not you will counted as late arrival
- If you have responded to a P2 page, please indicate on the H&P what time you contacted the Attending
- Should the pediatric trauma be placed in another trauma bay, the pediatric carts are on wheels and can be moved if needed
- If you cannot find what you need, please ask a member of the Emergency Department team
