



Donation After Cardiac Death (DCD) Virtual Medication Kit – 2023 UPDATE

Process

Original Contents	New Contents
Fentanyl 250mcg (50 mcg/mL)	Fentanyl 250mcg (50 mcg/mL)
Midazolam 10mg (5 mg/mL)	Midazolam 10mg (5 mg/mL)
Ketamine 50mg (50 mg/mL)	Ketamine 50mg (50 mg/mL)
Heparin 50,000 units (5,000 units/mL)	*Heparin 60,000 units (5,000 units/mL)
Glycopyrrolate 200mcg (200 mcg/mL)	Glycopyrrolate 200mcg (200 mcg/mL)

Step 1: RN will obtain kit contents by accessing the designated Omnicell machine in each adult ICU, selecting the appropriate patient, selecting **Remove Kits**, and selecting **DCD Adult** kit. **The RN assisting with the case should be the RN responsible for pulling medications.**

Step 2: Medication will be transported to the OR by the RN assisting with the case.

Step 3: RN will utilize the Sedation Narrator to complete all documentation during the case. **Begin by Adding Credentialed Provider that is responsible for medication orders.**

All kit contents are available for ordering and administration documentation under the “End of Life” drop down medication list.

Step 4: All partial doses will be wasted at the conclusion of the DCD case. **Wasting must be completed at the Omnicell where medications were dispensed by selecting the patient, selecting Waste Meds, and lastly by selecting Stored Meds to identify the medication.**
