Delirium

Who Does It Affect?

About 2 out of 3 ICU patients get delirium. 7 out of 10 patients get it while on the ventilator.

How Do We Assess For Delirium?

CAM-ICU should be performed and charted in the *Adult PCS Body System* Flowsheet every 12 hours.

Delirium Can Cause:

- Increased time on the ventilator
- Longer ICU and Hospital lengths of stay
- Increased costs
- Higher mortality –both in-hospital and after discharge
- Greater long-term cognitive dysfunction

How Do We Treat And Prevent Delirium?

- Repeated reorientation of patients
- A nonpharmacological sleep protocol
- Early mobilization activities
- Timely removal of catheters and physical restraints
- Early correction of dehydration
- Use of a scheduled pain management protocol
- Minimization of unnecessary noise/stimuli
- Review patient medications, sedatives and analgesics exacerbate delirium
