P1: Full trauma Team Activation

- ED Attending
- Trauma Attending- present within 15 minutes of patient arrival
- Trauma Chief
- ED Resident/APP
- Trauma Resident or APP
- Primary Nurse
- Respiratory therapist
- Clinical Assistant
- Recording Nurse
- STAT nurse (when available)
- Pharmacist
- ED Scribe
- OR charge nurse or other representative
- Anesthesia Representative (Staff, resident, CRNA or anesthesia assistant)
- X-Ray Tech
- EKG Tech
- Chaplain

P2: Partial Trauma Team Activation

- ED Attending
- Trauma Chief (or Trauma Attending)- present within 15 minutes of patient arrival
- ED Resident/APP
- Trauma Resident or APP
- Primary Nurse
- Clinical Assistant
- Recording Nurse
- Pharmacist
- Scribe
- OR charge nurse notified, not required to attend
- X-Ray Tech
- EKG Tech
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P3: Limited Trauma Team Activation

- ED Attending
- ED Resident/APP
- Trauma Resident or APP- present within 60 minutes of patient arrival
- Primary Nurse
- Clinical Assistant
- Recording Nurse
- Scribe

Side of Patient	Trauma Resident / APP	Primary Survey Resuscitative Lines ABG Other Procedures
Opposite Side of Patient	Primary Nurse Nurse Trainee Clinical Assistant	Vital Signs IV Access Administer Fluids/Medications Obtains Labs Secure Patient Belongings
Foot of Patient	Team Leader (Chief Trauma Resident or Trauma Attending)	Manage Resuscitation
Stand-by (Outside of Resuscitation Room or Behind the Line)	Scribe X-ray Tech EKG Operating Room Personnel Pharmacy Additional Trauma Team Members Consulting Services	Documents All Events During Resuscitation Await Instructions from the Team Leader to Enter the Resuscitation Room
