## **SBIRT**

## SCREENING, BRIEF INTERVENTION AND REFERRAL FOR TREATMENT

All trauma admission. Regardless of admitting service. Including Chidren 12 years of age or older.



Obtain UDS and BAL (No matter what the results still progress to the next step)



SBIRT staff member will create a daily list of admissions from the previous 24 hours. Each patient will be assessed for appropriateness to be screened that day based on a chart review.



SBIRT staff will review patients not seen on previous shifts due to medical or mental reasons to determine appropriatness of screening that day.



All trauma pateints will be screened for potential substance abuse, Depression, Anxiety, and PTSD prior to discharge. Any patient screening positive will recieve further screening, brief interventions and referral may be requested/indicated.



SBIRT staff will document after the patient has been evaluated or if not indicate why.

Any recommendations will be included in the patients EMR.



Request for Inpatient psychiatry consultation contact the trauma service - MD to enter consult order for inpatient psych evaluation. MD to follow up on those recommendations.
