

WVU Medicine Center for Nursing Education Application Checklist

Application materials can be submitted starting on August 15, 2024.

- Completed admission application (August 15 October 1 for first consideration; applications/application materials received after October 1 are not guaranteed to be considered)
- *Submit all high school and college transcripts, even if attended but did not complete the program. Send directly from issuing school to <u>CNEAdmissions@wvumedicine.org</u> by October 1, 2024 (If have GED or TASC, must also submit an admission application exemption form.)
 - Transcripts should be sent by the school to <u>CNEAdmissions@wvumedicine.org</u> by October 1, 2024 for first consideration
 - Unofficial transcripts can be submitted for the admission application, but final, official transcripts must be submitted by July 1, 2025 for prerequisite courses (high school or college-level Algebra, Chemistry, and English with grades of C or higher)
 - Will also accept Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus, or Calculus Algebra
- If applicable, submit Advanced Placement (AP) scores, CLEP scores, IB scores, etc.
- If applicable, current and unencumbered professional licenses and/or certifications
- Optional
 - One referral letter in PDF format. If letter is in a Word document, click save as and choose PDF file. If submit more than one letter, only first one will be considered.
 - Completed Admission Exemption Request Form, only if need to request something to be waived from admission consideration.
 - If have GED or TASC instead of high school diploma
 - If have below a 2.5 overall GPA for high school or college
 - If will not successfully pass a background check or a drug screen
 - If previously enrolled in another nursing program and cannot get a letter of good standing
 - ACT scores, only if competitive (19.9 or above is considered competitive).
 Our school code is 8215. Sign into https://my.act.org/ and request to send

- scores from your score dashboard using our school code. Use a credit card to pay for the scores.
- SAT scores, only if competitive (1050 or above is considered competitive for SAT). Our school code is 10264. Sign into https://mysat.collegeboard.org/login and request scores to be sent from Send SAT Scores page using our school code. Use a credit card to pay for your scores.
- TEAS scores, only if competitive (60 or above on each section is considered competitive on one single test). Send PDF score by logging on to ATI account, click on MY RESULTS, look under Proctored Exams, download your test score, and email to CNEAdmissions@wvumedicine.org.

Transcripts, scores, and optional application documents should all be submitted in PDF form electronically to CNEAdmissions@wvumedicine.org. Reminder, transcripts should be sent directly from the school(s). See *Tips for Sending Transcripts* handout on our website for additional help. In the body of the email, include your name and what you have attached. While we prefer electronic submission, you can also mail them to:
