

EASIEST TIPS

- Submit all requirements before the due date. **Applicants who do not submit all required materials do not make it to the second round.** Late materials are not accepted. Take time to read the application instructions and questions, answer them accurately and honestly.
- Submit **one** *professional* referral letter (only one, extras are not accepted).
- If you have a current, professional license or certification (see application instructions for more details), submit a copy of the current and valid license.

MORE INVOLVED TIPS

- Gain healthcare experience and clearly articulate that experience on the application.
- Complete prerequisites and general education requirements and submit the final transcripts before the end of the next application period.
- Consider doing a healthcare related skill set in phlebotomy, CNA, MA, ST, or pharmacy tech.
- Seek employment in healthcare for direct patient care experience. <https://wvumedicine.org/careers/>
- Study for and earn competitive test scores on the ACT or SAT and/or the TEAS exam (See application checklist for more details). **Only submit if it is competitive.**

MOST INVOLVED TIPS

- Apply to and complete a program for LPN, EMT, or RT.
- If had a low high school and/or college GPA, complete college-level coursework to show ability to be successful academically in current life circumstances.
