(1) Program Completion Rate

Program completion rate is calculated by dividing the number of students enrolled in a cohort by the number who complete the program within 150% of the published program length.

(2) Credentialing Exam Pass rate (1st attempt)

Credentialing exam pass rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who successfully complete the ARRT exam in Radiation therapy on their 1st attempt by the total number of graduates attempting the exam.

(3) Job Placement Rate

** In accordance with JRCERT Standards, the following exclusions are identified when determining the number of graduates "actively" pursuing employment: (1) Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts, (2) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, (3) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, (4) graduate is on active military duty, and/or (5) Graduate is continuing education.

(4) Graduate Satisfaction

Graduate satisfaction score is determined by calculating the mean score of Q 9 "Overall educational experience" on the Exit Survey, with a benchmark of 4.0 on a 5 point scale.
