# ST. JOSEPH'S HOSPITAL Inpatient Visitor Guidelines

# One Visitor per Hospitalized Patient Per Day:

## Noon to 7 pm

- Visitors must enter through the Main Hospital Entrance Monday— Friday, and the Emergency Department Entrance after 5 pm and on the weekends.
- Visitors will be screened at the Registration Desk and must wear a visitor badge at ALL times. They must be masked at ALL times.

#### Questions asked during screening will be:

- 1) Have you had symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 5 days such as new fever, cough or shortness of breath?
- 2) Have you or someone that you have been in contact with tested positive for the COVID-19 virus?

### If Screening is Positive, Visitation will not be Permitted

- Visitors of COVID Positive patients must remain in the patient's room and may not travel to common areas such as the Café, Gift Shop, etc.
- Visitors are required to maintain social distancing.
- Limited Exceptions will be made for Pediatrics, OB, and End-of Life Cases.
- In the OB department, visitors will be limited to one adult (of the mother's choice) during her hospitalization.

Visitors are not permitted in the Infusion/Chemotherapy Area
