

STUDENT DRESS CODE

It is required that all students present a clean, neat and professional appearance. Students are expected to dress professionally and conservatively.

Failing to follow the dress code will result in disciplinary action.

Students not complying with dress code will be sent home to change. PTO will be used for this purpose.

Uniforms: Students will wear black scrub pants and white scrub tops for all clinical and didactic education.

Black lab jackets may be worn.

White t-shirt may be worn under the scrub top.

Uniforms will be clean and unwrinkled.

Students must display hospital ID at all times.

Undergarments should be white and unobtrusive

Perfume: Excessive cologne or perfume is not permitted.

Nails: Fingernails will be clean and well groomed. Artificial nails are not permitted.

Earrings: Earrings will be limited to two per ear. No hoop earrings permitted.

Necklaces: One small necklace is permitted.

Bracelets: No bracelets permitted.

Watches: A wristwatch may be worn.

Rings: One ring per hand.
