Fee	Description	Semester	Cost
Admission Fee	Students are invoiced a \$50.00 nonrefundable admission fee upon acceptance into the program.	Semester I	\$50.00
Textbooks Costs	WVU Medicine does not sell textbooks. Students are responsible for purchasing their textbooks from a retailer of their choice. This is an estimated value and varies by market price.	Semester I	\$520.00
Uniforms: (5 sets) + Shoes	WVU Medicine does not sell or provide uniforms. Students can purchase uniforms for clinical rotations from a retailer of their choice but must follow the uniform requirements stated in dress code policy in the student handbook	Semester I	\$300.00
Tuition	Students are invoiced tuition on a semester basis with the due date being the first day of each academic semester. Tuition is \$2000 per semester for a total program cost of \$4000.	Semester I + II	\$4,000.00
Trajecsystm	Student utilize a web-based clinical management system for clinical evaluations, assessments and attendance documentation. Student are required to pay for this access upon enrollment into the program.	Semester I (One-time fee)	\$100.00
Ohio State MRI Seminar Student Registration	Students are required to attend the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center's annual MRI seminar during their 2nd semester and submit a poster project.	Semester II	\$250.00
Ohio State MRI Seminar Lodging	Hotel rooms are typically around \$150 per night. Students typically share the costs of the room and often subsidize costs by fund raising (optional). Students may also incur costs associated with travel to the conference location.	Semester II	\$300.00
Ohio State MRI Seminar Research Poster Project Costs	Students will submit a research project and will incur costs associated with having their project printed on a display board.	Semester II	\$80.00
Graduation Fees	Students are invoiced a \$25.00 graduation fee during their final semester	Semester II	\$25.00
ARRT Examination Fee:	During their final semester, students must apply to the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists to take the certifying exam in Magnetic Resonance Imaging.	Semester II	\$225.00
Total Estimated Costs			\$5,850.00
