

Private Student Loan Option

Students enrolled at West Virginia University Hospitals may be able to obtain private student loans through Sallie Mae pending eligibility. This funding option is available for students who require additional financial aid in excess of the funds available through the Direct Loan program or for students who are enrolled in programs that do not qualify for federal financial aid. Before applying for this type of loan, students should access the Sallie Mae website (<https://www.salliemae.com/>) and carefully read and consider all information provided regarding the terms and conditions of this type of loan.
